Shalom! I'm Larry the Lion and most honored to meet you!

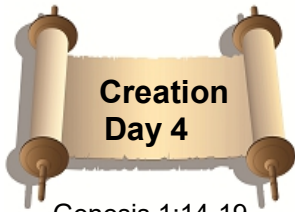


When we look around outside, it's amazing to see all of the wonderful things that Elohim created. Today we're going to start talking about what He made on Day 4. Do you have any guesses?

Hebrew Word of the Day



OT
אֹת
(*'ót*)



This Hebrew word for signs, **ot**, can mean a sign, a signal, a mark, or a warning.

Wow! So Elohim told us that He made the sun, moon, and stars as a way of showing us signs – or you could say like He's giving us clues.

If we watch carefully, these lights are signs that tell us when to start and end the day, as well as the new seasons, and Feasts.
