What do you think is the most important light in the sky?

Maybe the sun is because it's so big and it keeps us warm?
Maybe the moon is because it's so pretty in the night sky?

What about the stars? They look so tiny to us here on Earth - are they special? They don't light up the sky and they don't keep us warm... they just twinkle and sometimes we might see a shooting star.



Well, some might think the stars aren't very important because they don't have a big job, or because they look so small (even though they are really big!).

But did you know even the stars are important to Yah?

Psalms 147:4 tells us - "He appoints the number of the stars, He gives names to all of them."

Wow! He knows each and every star and has even named them! Everything He made is important and has a purpose, no matter how big or small - even you!



As you trace and color the star below, read the verses on each of the star points to learn what King David wrote about the stars. You'll also read what Elohim promised both to Abram and Issac, and then see that promised fulfilled!

Try to go outside one night and see if you can count the stars as you remember Yah's promise long ago.

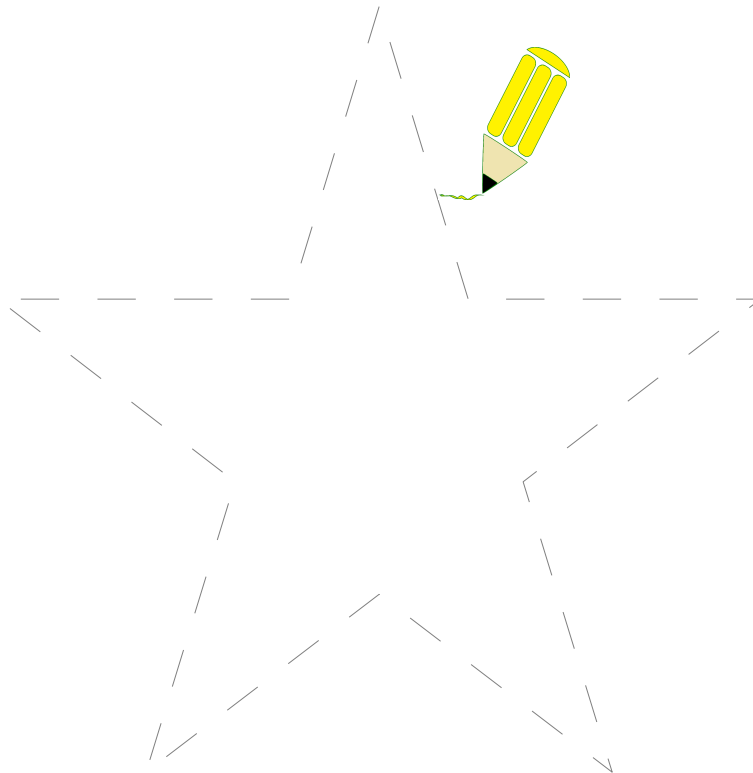
When we walk by faith and in obedience to Yah's Word, we are also heirs of the promise to Abraham!
